How to Join: Joining is actually very simple:

1. **Visit our website or Facebook page** – We have an online presence with sign-up info and schedules. Our website is: www.postpresby.org/srsoftball.htm
2. **League plays on Monday nights** – You can stop by the fields to watch, tryout, meet the players, and talk to league coaches and league organizers. Tryouts are March 9th and March 16th, 2026.
3. **Fill out a registration form** – You'll typically provide contact info, basic health or waiver forms, and a modest registration fee of \$75.00
4. **Get placed on a team** – New players are often assigned to a team to ensure a balanced level of play.



What It's Like?

- **A Fun and relaxed environment:** The emphasis is on enjoyment, teamwork, and staying active—not on competition or pressure.
- **Friendship and camaraderie:** Many players form lasting friendships; there's often plenty of joking, cheering, and post-game socializing.
- **Skill levels vary:** Whether you're a seasoned player or haven't swung a bat in years, there's a place for you.
- **Games on Monday nights:** This makes it easy for retirees or those still working to participate.



How the Club Works

- **Season:** The season runs from first of April through the end of September.
- **Teams:** Balanced teams are created to keep games fair and enjoyable.
- **Volunteer-run:** Most leagues are organized by player volunteers who handle scheduling, equipment, and events.
- **Special events:** There is also a post-season tournament, an All-Star Game, a skills competition and a year-end meeting.
- **Membership dues:** Modest membership fees help cover field rentals, insurance, and equipment.
