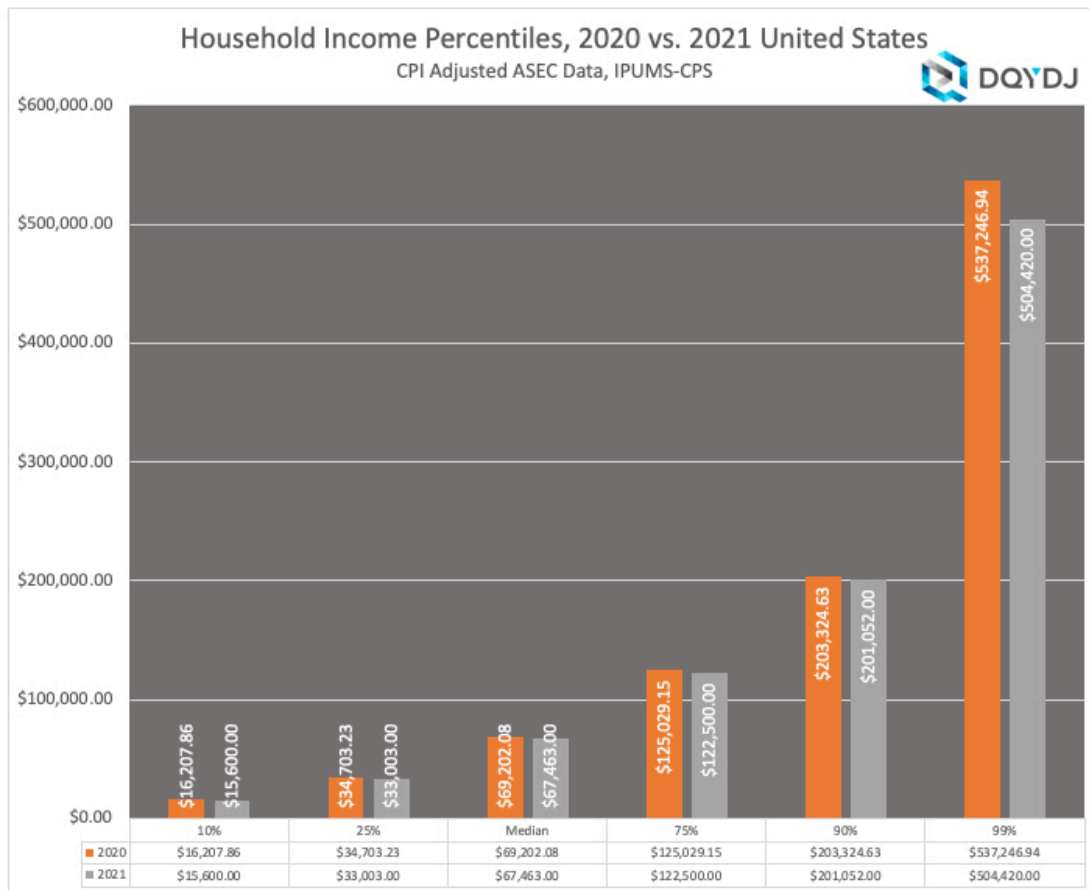

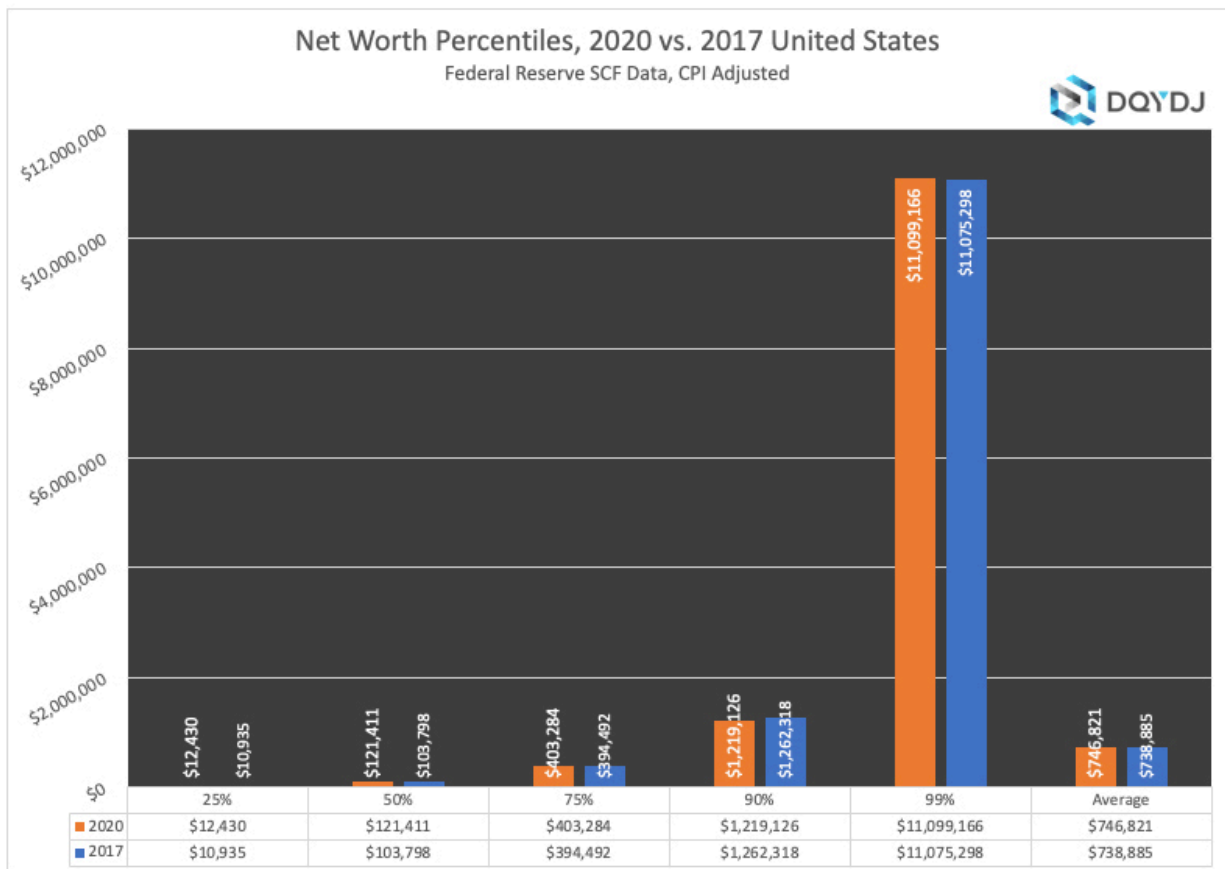

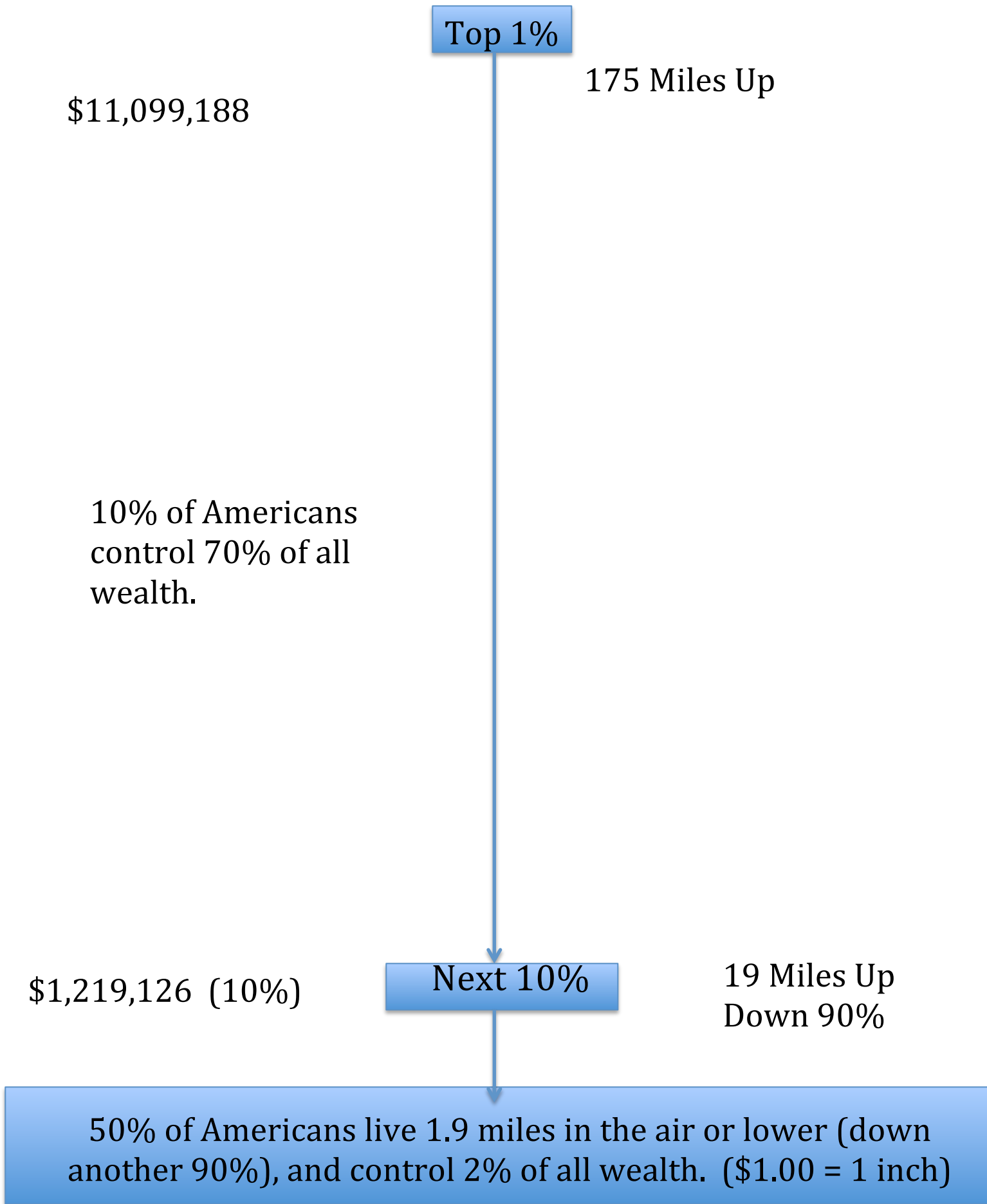


2020 vs 2021 US Household Income Percentile

10% of Americans control 70% of all wealth.

Next 10%

\$1,219,126 (10%)

19 Miles Up
Down 90%

50% of Americans live 1.9 miles in the air or lower (down another 90%), and control 2% of all wealth. (\$1.00 = 1 inch)

Remember: 10% of Americans have negative net worth and "live" underground.

Some perspective on the wealthiest of the wealthy: Net worth of these 10 individuals = \$1.3 Trillion (That's 1.3 THOUSAND BILLION).

The amount of wealth gained by these 10 people in one year = \$443 Billion.

The American Hospital Association estimates that indigent care costs American hospitals approximately \$40 billion a year.

The total \$1.3 Trillion net worth of these 10 people is equal to over 32 years worth of indigent hospital care. The money they earned last year alone would cover over 11 years of indigent care.

No one I know would suggest the "Top Ten" should bear the burden of indigent care, although many of our nation's wealthiest individuals think the government should **not** do so. "Repeal and replace Obamacare!"

And on the subject of the Eiffel Tower:

1. The average net worth of the "Top Ten" is \$130 billion dollars.
2. Converting dollars to distance (\$1.00 = 1 inch), the Top Ten's average "distance" above ground is 2,051,767 miles. That is 8.5 times the distance between the Earth and the Moon (239,000 miles.)

Remember again that half the U.S. population is lower than 2 miles up on this comparative index. 10% of the US population has negative net worth, and is "below ground."

P.S. Bezos is 3.2 million miles up – 13x Earth to Moon.
